Formerly Talking About Teaching, UP North is a new Learning & Teaching conference organised by York St John University, aiming to be the flagship symposium for pedagogic research and development in the North of England.



Dr David Roberts will deliver the keynote speech for this year's symposium, he is Senior Lecturer in Peace and Conflict Studies at Loughborough University and Senior Fellow of the HEA. His background lies in fieldwork in Cambodia during the peacekeeping mission, Viet Nam just after and more recently, Sierra Leone and South Sudan. He is primarily now interested in the power of dominant pedagogies to prevail despite their potential inadequacies and has, with the support of the HEA and his own institution, spent the last 4 years devising, developing and evaluating a multidisciplinary, multimedia lecture method.



Call for Proposals

We are asking for proposals that fall under the headline theme of **Inspired Learning**, and more specifically that relate to one of the thematic areas listed below. TEACHING - Pedagogic approaches that inspire learning, for example improved use of established tools and technologies such as PowerPoint and VLEs, innovative classroom practice, online or blended learning, developing supportive relationships with learners, curriculum design, the use of innovative technologies including augmented and virtual reality.



EXPERIENCE - Opportunities for learners to engage in activities within and beyond the curriculum that enable them to apply their knowledge and understanding, such as industry experience, field trips, conferences, learning by doing, service learning, social innovation.



ASSESSMENT - Authentic assessment, work-based learning and assessment, live briefs and real-world projects, assessment linked with industry, use of technology for assessment, alternative forms of assessment.



RESEARCH - Research into the scholarship of teaching and learning, innovative research in teaching approaches, collaborative staff and student research activities, opportunities for learners to co-create or to present research.



LEARNER VOICE / PARTNERSHIP - Collaborative and partnership work with learners, such as student representation, collaborative curriculum design, collaborative research, innovative approaches to module evaluation.
